## SPEAKERS



**Robin “Montana” Williams** is the Chief of the National Cybersecurity Education & Awareness Branch, Department of Homeland Security, Washington, D.C. His office is responsible for coordinating and developing national cybersecurity awareness, education, training, professional development, policy, standards, and assessment requirements to broaden, cultivate, and maintain an unrivaled, globally competitive cybersecurity workforce for the nation.

**Dr. Ray Vaughn** joined UAH, a National Center of Academic Excellence in Information Assurance Education, in May 2013 as Vice President for Research. Dr. Vaughn’s research interests are cybersecurity and software engineering with a special focus on industrial control systems security. He has more than 100 publications to his credit and has obtained more than \$40M in funded research projects. Dr. Vaughn’s topic will address current cybersecurity scholarship opportunities, based on the recent \$4.2M grant awarded to the University of AL in Huntsville.

**CyberPatriot** is a national high school cyber-defense competition which excites, educates, and motivates students to pursue careers in cybersecurity and other STEM related fields. Grissom’s Cyber Patriot team finished 7th in the Semi-Finals, and 2nd in the National Finals in March 2014. During the CyberPatriot National Finals the team remediated security vulnerabilities in Windows and Linux servers while simultaneously defending against hackers, decoded file data to reveal hidden information, designed and configured a computer network, and performed a forensic investigation on a crime scene. Meet the team as they perform a cyber demonstration this evening.

**Benjamin McGee** is an Adjunct Instructor in Cybersecurity at the University of Alabama in Huntsville, as well as, the Chief Scientist at Aleta Technologies. Mr. McGee is a graduate of the University of Florida, holds a Masters of Science in Cybersecurity, an official ECICouncil Certified Ethical Hacker Instructor, and is the President of the North Alabama Chapter of Information Systems Security Association.

**Larry Hampel** is a DoDIIS Security and Information Assurance Manager with the Department of Defense. He has over 24 years of experience in the information systems security field, as well as, holding positions with responsibilities as a Sr. System/Network Admin and Trusted Local Admin for local governmental agencies, businesses, and educational facilities. He holds over 17 certifications, including, Cyber Law 2 and DoDIIS CRM Orders Business Intelligence.
